About the Program

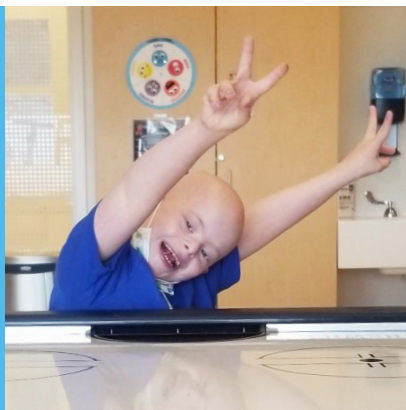
